### Directed Study Policy

Direct study policy is designed to be a substitute for a traditional course that is not offered in the semester for which the student wishes to enroll. The material covered in such courses is essentially the same as that covered in the traditional course.

#### Policy

- Direct study courses used only for student who will be graduated in same semester.
- The student must have a minimum CGPA of 2.75.
- All direct study courses must be approved by Instructor, Department Head, and the College Dean.
- Instructor must follow the exact syllabus of the regularly taught course.
- No more than one Directed Study course may be taken during the student enrollment in the University.
- No Directed Study will be approved for the purpose of repeating a course to remove a previous unsatisfactory grade.
- Directed study courses should not normally be used as replacements for required courses or as a solution to routine scheduling problems.
- Previously failed courses cannot be taken as Direct Study course
- Direct Study courses cannot be taken on Pass/Fail basis.
